Clyde Barrow – THIS ROLE HAS BEEN CAST.

Bonnie Parker – THIS ROLE HAS BEEN CAST.

Buck Barrow – Age 25-35. Male. Clyde's brother and an outlaw troubled by his wife's distaste for his lifestyle. Adventurous and loyal. Vocal range top: G4, Vocal range bottom: B2

Blanche Barrow – Age 25-35. Female. A religious woman who disapproves of the criminal lifestyle. Honorable and righteous. Married to Buck Barrow. Vocal range top: Eb5, Vocal range bottom: G3

Cumie Barrow – Age 40-55. Female. A kind woman among those suffering in the Depression. Loyal and selfless. Mother to Clyde and Buck

Sheriff Schmid – Age 30-45. Male. Local law enforcement.

Ted Hinton – Age 18-25. Male. A police officer struggling to separate his feelings from his duties. Kind and honest. Madly in love with Bonnie. Vocal range top: A4, Vocal range bottom: C3

Young Clyde – Age 8-12. Male. Vocal range top: A5, Vocal range bottom: B3

Young Bonnie – Age 8-12. Female. Vocal range top: C5, Vocal range bottom: C#4

Emma Parker – Age 40-55. Female. Bonnie's widowed mother. Fragile, caring, sensitive.

Preacher – Age 45-65. Male. The town's evangelist. Loud, passionate, boisterous. Vocal range top: C5, Vocal range bottom: A2

Henry Barrow – Age 45-55. Male. A hard-working man, struggling to survive. Humble and quiet. Father of Clyde and Buck.

Governor Miriam Ferguson – Age 40-60. Female. An enforcer of the law and Governor of Texas. Tough and harsh.

Captain Frank Hamer – Age 45-65. Male. A retired Texas Ranger who joins the hunt for Bonnie and Clyde. Recruited by Governor Ferguson.

Bob Alcorn – Age 30-45. Male. The best sharpshooter in Texas. Recruited by Frank Hamer, he helps hunt down Bonnie and Clyde.

Ensemble – Store Clerks; Cops/Guards; Bank Customers; Congregation; Choir; Bread Line Folks. Limited dance experience needed.

All auditionees are asked to sing a short selection of a musical theater song that shows off your voice. We want to make this easy for you, so bring your own track to sing along to! (We'll have a Bluetooth speaker for you to use.) Please provide a headshot. You will also be asked to share your conflicts for the rehearsal period.

REHEARSAL & PERFORMANCE DATES: Rehearsals will start in June and run through opening. The rehearsal schedule will be built around conflicts. Show dates are Aug 2-4 and 8-11. Thursdays and Fridays at 7:30pm and Saturdays and Sundays at 3pm (no Saturday night shows). Actors must be available for all technical rehearsals, dress rehearsals, and performances to be cast.
